In our opinion:

- the contracts, transactions and dealings entered into by the Retakaful Division during the year ended 31 March 2018 that we have reviewed are in compliance with the principles of Shariah;
- 2. there were no earnings that have been realised/unrealised from sources or by means prohibited by the principles of Shariah; and
- 3. the calculation of zakat are in compliance with the principles of Shariah.
